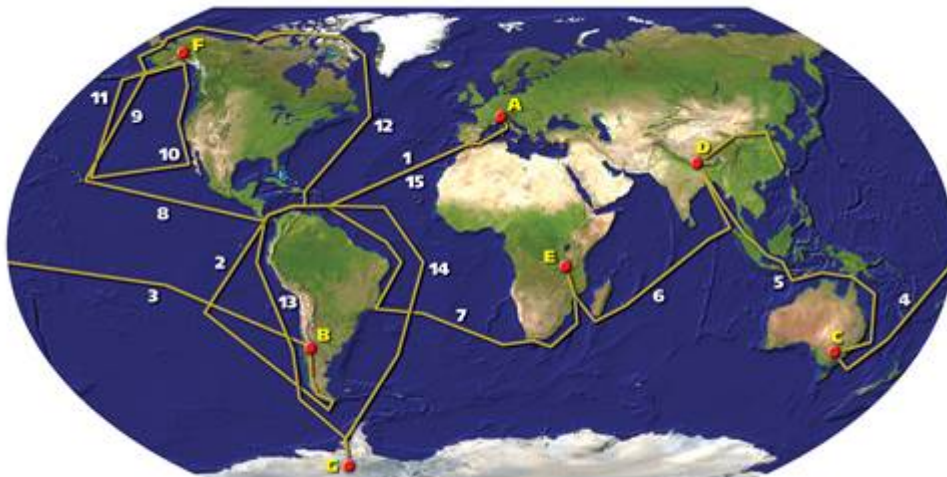

What is the TOPtoTOP Expedition?

The expedition started in 2000, setting out to travel to the highest TOP on each of the seven continents all under nature's power and human force; sailing – cycling – climbing. This to connect schools in all climate zones and to explore top solutions to protect the planet as well as inspiring as many young people world-wide to act for earth's future, see www.toptotop.org.



To date the expedition has sailed 70'000 miles, cycled 20'000 km and climbed 400'000 m in altitude to visit and inspire over 80'000 children in more than 100 countries, as well as cleaning up beaches to mountain tops along the way. All our 4 children were born on the expedition. Volunteers from more than 47 nations have joined so far.

Outlook: After San Diego the expedition will cycle back to San Francisco and sail to the Arctic first to go from POLE to POLE, 1st time in a figure 8 around the Americas to Mount Vinson our last TOP in Antarctica
